

7. Travel through Amphipolis and Appollonia to Thessalonica. Paul reasoned with the Jews from the scriptures for 3 sabbaths. Many believed in Christ (Ac.17:1-4). The unbelieving Jews stir up trouble (Ac.17:5-9).

8. Travel to Berea and they receive the Word (Ac. 7:10-12). Men from Thessalonica follow Paul to stir up the people (Ac.17:13). Paul departs to the sea while Silas and Timothy remain in Berea (Ac.17:14).

9. Travel to Athens and requests Silas and Timothy to meet him there (Ac.17:14-15). Paul disputes with the Jews and devout persons (Ac.17:16-18). Paul is brought to Areopagus and Mars Hill to teach about his "new" doctrine (Ac.17:19-34) and some believe.

10. Travel to Corinth and met Aquila and Priscilla (Jews

from Rome) who also were tentmakers (Ac.18:1-3). Paul reasoned in the synagogue every sabbath, and persuaded both Jews and Greeks (Ac.18:4). Silas and Timothy find Paul (Ac.18:5). Because the Jews oppose and blaspheme, Paul determines to go to the Gentiles (Ac.18:6). Many Corinthians believed. Paul taught the Word of God for 1 year and 6 months (Ac.18:7-11). The Jews brought Paul before Gallio, but he does not care about the issue (Ac.18:12-17).

6. Paul and Silas in prison pray and sing and an earthquake frees them (Ac.16:25-26). The keeper asks how to be saved (Ac.16:27-34). The magistrates try to free Paul privily and find out that Paul is a Roman. Paul goes back to the house of Lydia (Ac.16:35-40).

5. Paul finds a woman with a spirit of divination and he casts out the spirit, but the owners have them beat and imprisoned (Ac.16:16-24).

4. Travel from Troas to Samothracia, Neapolis to Philippi (Ac.16:11-12). Paul met Lydia who was from Thyatira (Ac.16:13-15).

3. Travel through Phrygia and Galatia. The Holy Spirit forbids Paul to go in Asia and Bithynia (Ac.16:6-10). Paul's vision of a man in Macedonia.

2. Travel through Syria and Cilicia. Paul meets Timothy for the first time (Ac.16:1-5).

1. In Jerusalem, Paul decides to revisit the cities he previously preached to (Ac.15:36-41). Paul and Barnabas debate whether John Mark should come on this missionary journey. Paul and Barnabas go separate ways.



PAUL'S SECOND MISSIONARY JOURNEY

11. Paul, along with Priscilla and Aquila, travel to Ephesus. Paul reasoned with the Jews in the synagogue and they desire him to stay (Ac.18:18-21). Paul leaves Priscilla and Aquila there.

12. Paul leaves Ephesus for Caesarea, and then to Antioch (Ac.18:21-22).
